The Wines of Catherine Marshall, Elgin South Africa, 24 May 2018 19.45 The Cottage

We are delighted to welcome Catherine Marshall from Elgin, South Africa to our tasting room Thursday 24th May; what began as a festive three barrel foot stomp event attended by a handful of friends on a south peninsula beach in

1996, produced a very palatable Syrah, and saw the founding in 1997 of the first true micro-winery in the Western Cape with Pinot Noir the main focus.

The 2016 Finite Elements Pinot Noir was awarded a fantastic 95/100 by Tim Atkin MW in his 2017 South African Report, making it one of the highest scoring Pinot Noir's he rated.

The 2015 vintage of Ornellaia, which marks its 30th vintage anniversary, is without doubt one of the great Ornellaia vintages. The usual deep colour announces a wine of great texture and intensity, followed by a fruit-rich nose that is ripe and fresh at the same time, emphasized by classic balsamic and spicy hints. On the palate, it is rich, dense, and full-bodied, with an exceptional tannic texture, dense and velvety, of great refinement, that extends throughout the palate.

The Le Volte is one of the great Tuscan bargains!




[April Wines of the Month £126](#)

We are all hoping that some warmer, even milder weather is just around the corner.. as ever loads of new wines have been tasted and some spring like, brighter fresher styles are making their debut in this splendid and varied mixed case. This month's case also features some new vintages of old favourites, and even a delicious German Chardonnay!



The fantastic [Ancora Charetto Rose 2017 £6.99](#) is currently our well-timed Wine of the Week! "Just one of the best al fresco party rose's I've tried for ages" Clare B. This new 2017 is simply delicious. Amazing value! Appealing, lively north Italian rosé, made from Barbera and Pinot Nero grapes, with refreshing acidity and crisp strawberry fruit characters. Fresh yet delicate strawberry and redcurrant aromas. Ripe and juicy fruit on the palate, with good substance and weight balanced by crisp acidity.



[Il Poggione Brunello di Montalcino 2012 & Riserva Paganelli](#)

More fabulous Brunello! Il Poggione has become a huge NYW favourite; the regular 2012 is simply great, one of the values of the vintage, and quite forward in style, though will age happily. We also have a smallish parcel of the fabulous, opulent yet structured Riserva Vigna Paganelli 2012.



[Bodegas Borsao](#)

Is there a winery anywhere making such good value wines as the perennial NYW favourite Bodegas Borsao? We have been selling and drinking these fabulous wines for 15 years and they never disappoint. We have the latest vintage of the fabulous Garnacha's (Grenache) both the regular (just over £6 a bottle by the case) and the fabulous Selección Especial Garnacha which always gets great press. On top of that 2 fairly new releases. These are pretty big full-flavoured wines - Bole a lovely rich, smoky Garnacha Syrah blend, and the even bigger flashier Zarihs Syrah, made by the superstar Chris Ringland, based in Australia and maker of many very impressive and highly rated wines, who has been working with Borsao for many years now. Lastly the fabulous new vintage of the voluptuous, old vine 'Tres Picos' Garnacha. These are all drinking really well now but there is no hurry.
